CURATOR, THE INDIANA UNIVERSITY AXOLOTL COLONY - A person is needed to coordinate operations of the Axolotl Colony, a laboratory which raises and distributes genetically defined salamanders for research purposes. Duties include: over-seeing the health of the animals; supervising student caretakers; and facilitating the maintenance of animal stocks. The curator will be involved in setting and executing future goals of the colony, and must work harmoniously with other members of the laboratory and the Biology Department.

Reguirements: a degree in science: Personnel management experience is highly recommended and work experience in biology would be helpful: Prior experience with amphibians is desirable, but not necessary. The successful applicant will have to have demonstrated a superior organizational ability as well as the ability to work well with people.

This will be a permanent position. Depending upon the availability and qualifications of the successful applicant, the position will be established as either a half-time or full-time position. Likewise, salary is flexible, and will depend upon the general arrangements of the position and the qualifications of the successful applicant.
