

WORKSHOP ON AMPHIBIAN LARVAL BIOLOGY

A teaching workshop on Amphibian Larval Biology will be held at the 1983 joint meeting of the American Society of Ichthyologists and Herpetologists, the Herpetologist^(US) League, and the Society for the Study of Amphibians and Reptiles, University of Oklahoma, Norman, July 30, 1984. The workshop is designed as a minicourse for the non-expert on these organisms; no prior experience in herpetology or systematics is presumed. Among the people who may be interested in this workshop are general biologists, graduate students in herpetology outside of amphibian biologists, freshwater ecologists, developmental biologists and amateur herpetologists.
