Axolotl food pellets are made from ground fish (Anchovies) pressed into a pellet form and combined with important vitamins and minerals.

We buy our pellets in large quantities from Rangen Inc. and repackage them for sale to researchers in the scientific community and private hobbiests because Rangen does not sell their pellets in small quantities. These pellets are not controlled for Thyroxine levels. Neither Rangen Inc. nor the Indiana University Axolotl Colony are responsible if your axolotl undergoes metamorposis after eating these pellets.

Fish Meal, Wheat Feed Flour, Blood Meal, Fish Oil, Ascorbic Acid, Biotin, Choline Chloride, Folic Acid, Niacin, Pantothenic Acid (d-calcium panothenate), Pyridoxine (hydrochloride), Riboflavin, Thiamine (mononitrate), Vitamin B12 supplement, Vitamin A (acetate), Vitamin D (d-activated animal sterol), Vitamin E (dl-alpha tocopheryl acetate), Vitamin K3 (menadione sodium bisulfite complex), Copper Sulfate, Manganese Sulfate, Potassium Iodate, Salt, Zinc, Sulfate, Ethoxyquin (preservative), Proprionic Acid, Sorbic Acid, Propylene Glycol, Canthaxanthin.
